



3 ON 3 LEAGUE RULES

- Each game will last **20 minutes** or until a team scores **21 points**. If the game goes into overtime, the first team to score 2 points will be the winner.
- There will be a 3-minute warm-up between games, or when both coaches are ready.
- Each team will have two :30-second timeouts per game

Scoring:

- Basket inside the 3-point line: 1 Point
- Basket beyond the 3-point line: 2 Points
- Free throw: 1 Point

Fouls:

- 5 team fouls = bonus.
- No personal fouls will be kept.
- Shooting foul inside the 3-point line: 1 free throw attempt
- Shooting foul beyond the 3-point line: 2 free throw attempts
- Foul in the act of a successful field goal (And-1): 1 free throw attempt
- Non-shooting fouls when a team is in the bonus: 1 free throw attempt

Basketballs:

- All Girls will play with a 28.5 basketball.
- Boys 3rd-7th grade will play with a 28.5 basketball.
- Boys 8th-12th grade will play with a 29.5 basketball.
- The opening possession will be determined by a rock-paper-scissors.
- On change of possession where the ball doesn't go into the basket, the ball needs to be taken back behind the 3-point line. Both feet need to be behind the 3-point line to take the ball back. If a turnover occurs outside the 3-point line, the defensive team then has the opportunity to immediately attack the basket.
- The ball will be checked after each made basket or dead ball.

- On a made shot or stoppage in play, the offense is allowed a FREE PASS outside the 3-point line, but offensive players can be guarded inside the 3-point line. On-ball defender cannot pressure in-bounder outside the 3-point line.
- Substitutions allowed on dead balls only.
- Jump balls are alternating possessions like a standard 5v5 game.
- Teams need to provide their own jerseys. Some teams wear the same color of shirts, and other teams have special shirts/jerseys made for this league. The choice is up to you.
- An unofficial :25-second shot clock will be in effect.
- Stalling or failing to play actively (not trying to score) is illegal and will result in a turnover.
- A player may only play on one team at the same grade level
- Parents:
 - One parent from each team will be the score keeper for the game.
 - No complaints about the officials are allowed.
 - No badgering/mocking of the officials is allowed during the game.
 - Do not "help" the officials with their calls - this is inappropriate behavior.
 - If inappropriate behavior becomes an issue, expulsions/suspensions will be handled by the site director. An expulsion/suspension from two different league dates will result in a permanent suspension for the remainder of the season.
